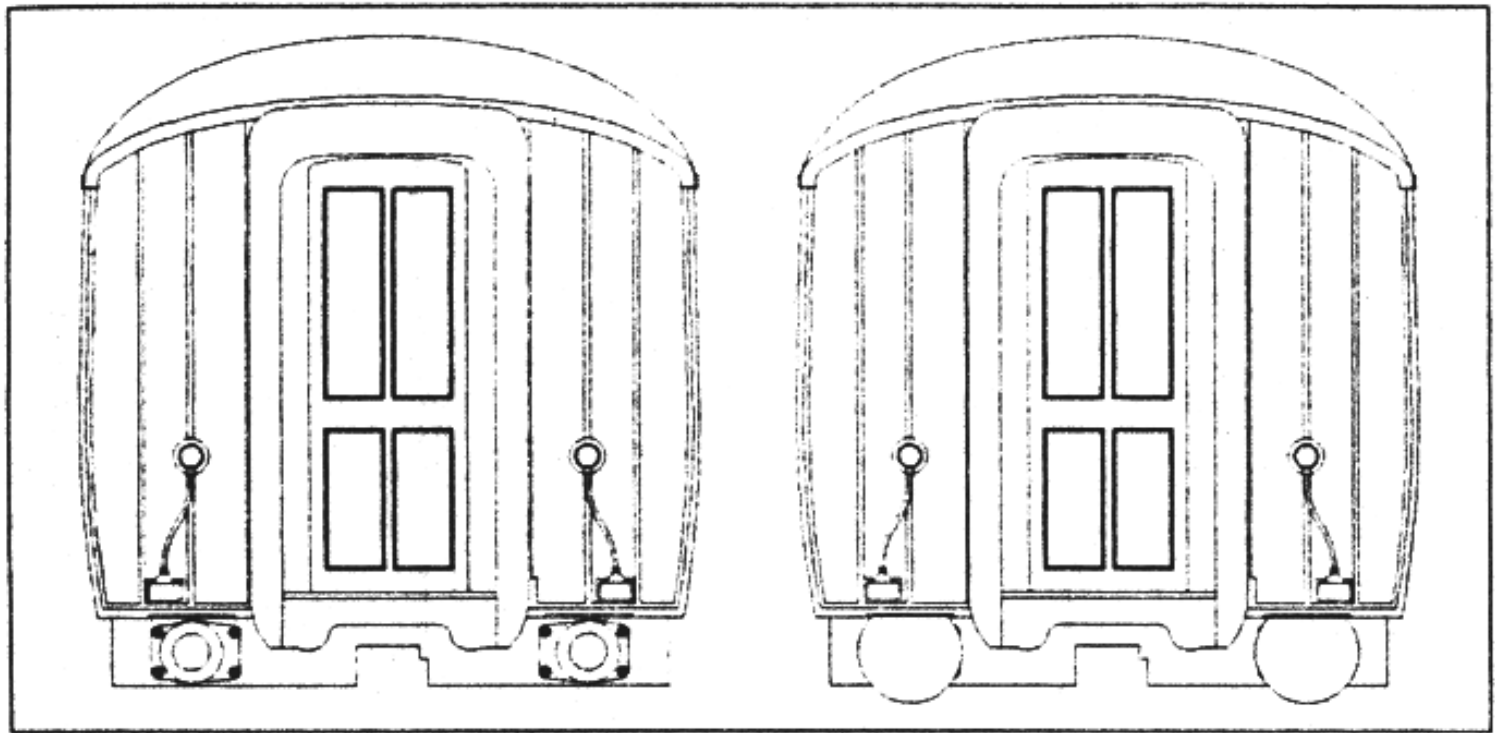

General Arrangement for Fitting MJT Gresley Coach Buffers (Ref 2807)
